





Asked if Guo might have left the country using the "backdoor," the BI official noted that the question should be directed to the Philippine Coast Guard (PCG) and the Philippine Navy.

An ILBO is issued for prudence to double-check if there are any pending arrest warrants against the subjects, or monitor their itineraries and whereabouts, should they attempt to leave the country.

Earlier, the National Bureau of Investigation confirmed that the suspended mayor and Guo Hua Ping are the same person.

Guo is accused of being an enabler of illegal Philippine Offshore Gaming Operation (POGO) hubs.

Guo, whose identity and citizenship have been placed under scrutiny, was placed under a six-month preventive suspension without pay by the Office of the Ombudsman on May 31 following the administrative complaints of the Department of the Interior and Local Government for grave misconduct, serious dishonesty, gross neglect of duty and conduct prejudicial to the best interest of the service.

She has also faced an inquiry by the Senate Committee on Women, Children, Family Relations, and Gender Equality.

MANILA - Almost all areas in the country will experience rains due to a low pressure area (LPA) and the southwest monsoon, the weather bureau said on Thursday.

"The LPA, last tracked in the vicinity of Catbalogan City, Samar, has a slim chance of developing into a tropical cyclone," Philippine Atmospheric, Geophysical and Astronomical Services Administration (PAGASA) forecaster Aldczar Aurelio said.

However, the LPA will continue causing scattered rain showers and thunderstorms over the Visayas, Bicol Region, Caraga, Marinduque, Romblon, Cagayan, Isabela, Quirino, Aurora, Bulacan, Laguna, Rizal, and Quezon.

The same weather condition will prevail across Metro Manila, Bataan, Zamboanga Peninsula, Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao, Northern Mindanao, and the rest of Calabarzon

and Mimaropa. Moderate to heavy rains in those areas could result in flash floods or landslides, PA-GASA said.

The rest of the country will





Under the Bangsamoro Organic Law (BOL), 80 parliamentary seats are at stake in the polls while 18,271 national and local positions are up for grabs in the midterm polls involving 14 various positions.

These are senatorial, party-list representatives, congressional district representatives, governors, vice governors, provincial board members, city/municipal mayors, vice mayors, and councilors.

An EDCVL is a list where voters sign and affix their thumbmarks during election day. It also contains the serial number of used ballots to prove that a person has voted.

DA: Lower rice prices due to tariff cut may be felt by August

MANILA - The public may start to feel lower rice retail prices next month as imported rice with lower tariffs started coming in, the Department of Agriculture (DA) said on Friday.

Executive Order (EO) 62, which lowered the tariffs on imported rice from 35 percent to 15 percent, was implemented last July 5.

Severe thunderstorms could also result in flash floods or landslides.





Phivolcs staff to get Japan training on quake, tsunami monitoring



MANILA - The Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA) will help boost the capacity of the Philippine Institute of Volcanology and Seismology (Phivolcs) in earthquake and tsunami analysis and monitoring.

The record of discussions between the two agencies was signed at the Phivolcs' auditorium in Quezon City on Tuesday.

Phivolcs Director Teresito Bacolcol said the project aims to capacitate their technical staff in delivering timely and ac- Department of Science and curate information concerning earthquake and tsunamis.

"This is Japan's commitment and contribution to the promotion of international cooperation, especially towards developing countries," he told the Philippine News Agency.

Phivolcs will send employees for short term training in Japan. Two employees will also be sent for graduate studies from 2025 to 2026, and one from 2026 to 2027.

There will also be short visits of Japanese experts to the Phi-

"JICA will send experts on volcanology, seismology and tsunami to help capacitate Phivolcs technical staff," Bacolcol said.

Technology (DOST) Secretary Renato Solidum Jr. said the project also includes capacity development for information dissemination through masteral courses, as well as training for standard operating procedures for earthquakes and tsunamis.

Experts from the Japan Meteorological Agency and partner universities will hold the train-

"By focusing on data analysis, warning, and risk communication, we aim to develop a more robust earthquake monitoring and tsunami early warning system. This initiative will benefit vulnerable communities within the Philippines and extend its impact across the region," Solidum said.

He thanked JICA, represented by Takema Sakamoto, for the support.

"We recognize Japan's unparalleled expertise and technological advancements in disaster mitigation and preparedness, and are eager to incorporate these insights into our systems," Solidum said. (PNA)


